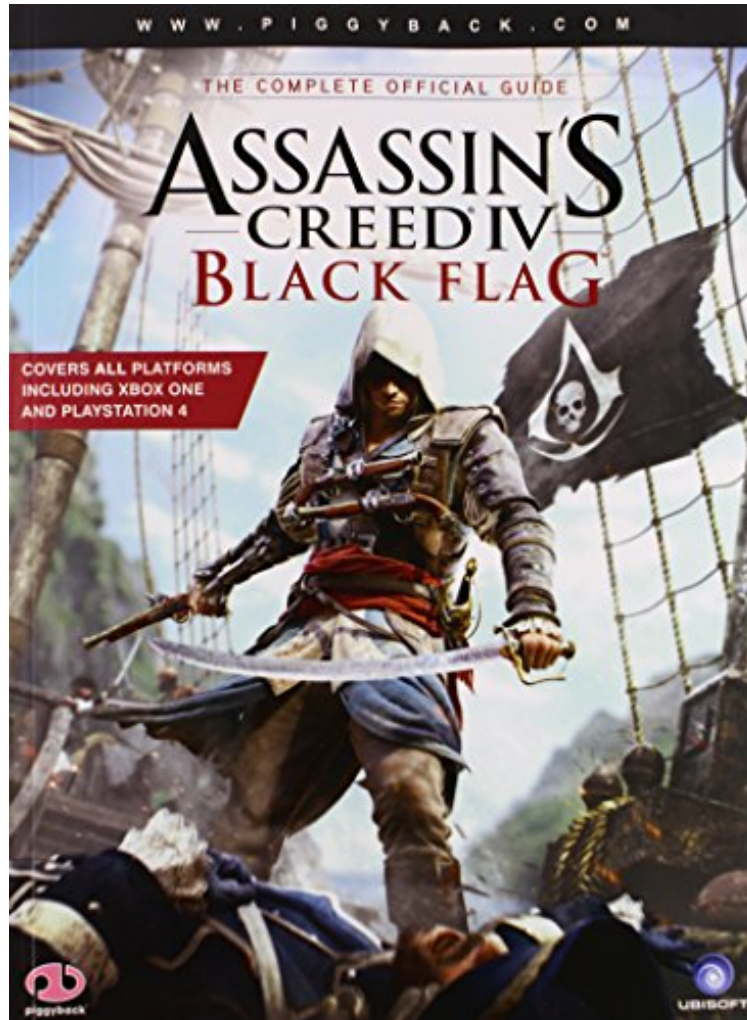

BourneI don't normally purchase strategy guides since I can find most information I need online for free, but I have to say, this purchase is one I am extremely pleased with. For starters, the cover has a "soft" touch to it, which gives it a unique feel and will fit in perfectly on your bookshelf when you're done consulting it.You get a complete walkthrough of the main storyline, detailed maps of all the little islands with exactly where the buried treasures are, plus this really great "QA" section in the back which explains the "present day" story in detail, just in case you missed a detail or two

during your playthrough. The authors give you tips and tricks that you simply wouldn't know by playing the game, for example, in Nassau when you first arrive, the pirate fort in the NE appears to have enemies, but they won't actually attack you until a bit later in the game, so if you're gonna go exploring in that area, do it as soon as you drop anchor in town. There's also a nice section in the front which gives a quick overview of each of the previous Assassin's Creed games so you aren't completely lost if this is your first game of the series. I highly recommend this version of the strategy guide!

Managed to get this after I finished the story (something I was not planning on, but there you go.) The cover and jacket are super nice. It's been finished with sort of a rubber feel to it. The jacket has Kenway on it. The picture on the cover is the book without the jacket. The binding is very crisp and sort of tight, so be sure to open it properly or you'll possibly damage it. The pages are very bright, well designed, and easy to read. Index and Table of contents are really simple as well. The book itself is very handy. It is definitely worth having during and after story game play. Everything I could think of (except for treasure maps, from what I could find) is in here in explicit detail. They take first person screenshots and manage to show arrows as to where you should go. They give you strategies for multiplayer, facing the various types of enemies and ships, and how to go through the story and assassinations with 100% sync. At the end of the book, they give a sort of history of pirates from the game and from actual life. It's pretty neat because they also include sketches and other development and behind-the-scenes images. So, if you are also interested in design and game art, it's worth it just for that, honestly.
