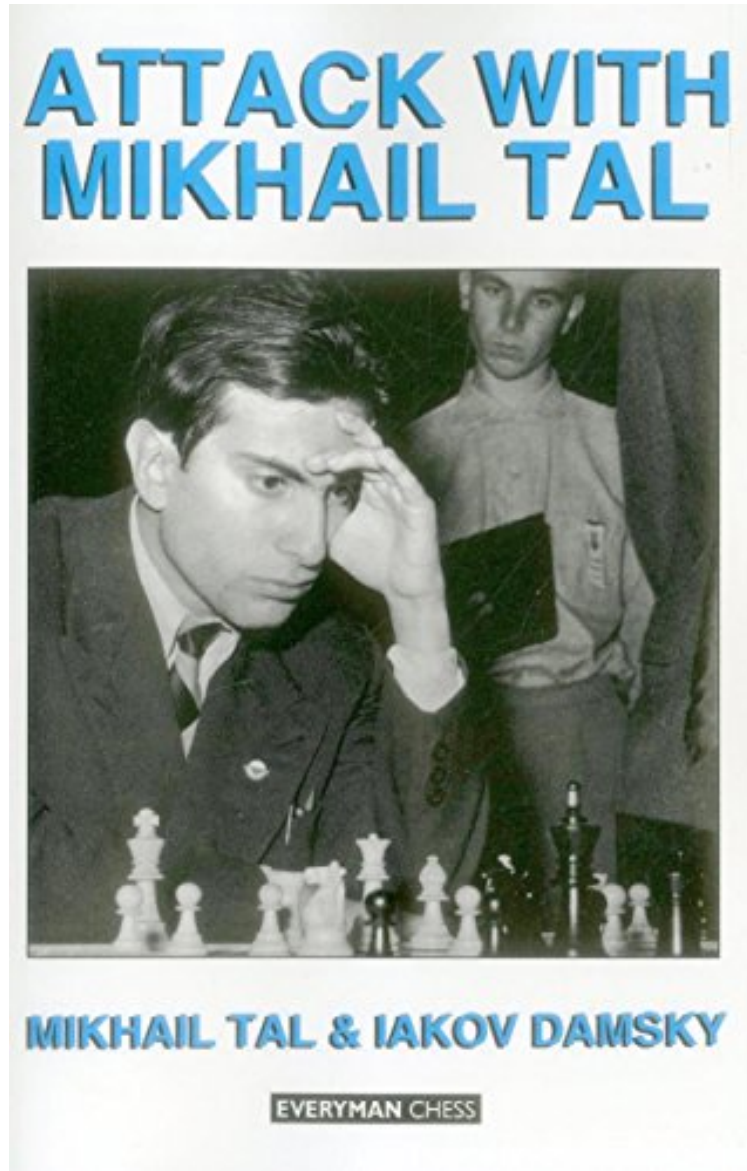

Appropriate variations are given so you're not left wondering well why did he not try this

move, or what was he trying to avoid. The concepts are amazing. Not just simple ideas but I was shocked at just how far ahead Tal had to see when making certain moves. I'd understand the idea, then get lost wondering why/how he employed the idea. Then after working through the variations on my iPad, was amazed at his foresight. If you want simple read a different book. If you want to see all the ideas you've read about in other manuals like The Middlegame Book one and Book two or The Art of Attack in Chess in action being applied then you'll want to walk through these games with Tal.
