Good idea, not great quality.By MarahuteI love the adult coloring book phenomenon, and especially books that don't just have page after page of super detailed mandalas. On top of that, the images are printed on a piece of paper and NOT double-sided! So I was more than happy to purchase this.I do have a few gripes.-because there is nothing on the other side of the sheet of the image you're coloring, you don't have to worry about bleedthrough, which is great. But the paper itself is quite cheap, and if you're using markers, you DO have to worry about the color bleeding onto the next image, which is a bummer.-the art isn't fantastic, which is actually a plus for me. I don't want to open a coloring book and see something so amazing that I'm afraid to color it. However, the art IS inconsistent. You can tell the artist put a lot more work into Gaea and Persephone than into Aphrodite and Pele. Regarding Persephone, I also feel the shading was improper; I understand the intent, but it's a coloring book, we

should be able to shade for ourselves. Some of the images are drawn with a much heavier stroke than others, which feels inconsistent...see Eagle Woman vs. Mami Wata. And then some images just aren't printed very well, like Hina; the lines are not smooth, and it's clearly an inconsistency with the printer in her case; Kali and Pele have the same issue, albeit to a lesser degree. Finally, all the mandalas just seem kind of blurry, like they were printed from smaller images and had to be stretched to fit the page. I gave this four stars because even though I can get a big ol' Lisa Frank book at the dollar store, I like supporting independent artists, especially ones who take the time to single-print their pages.
