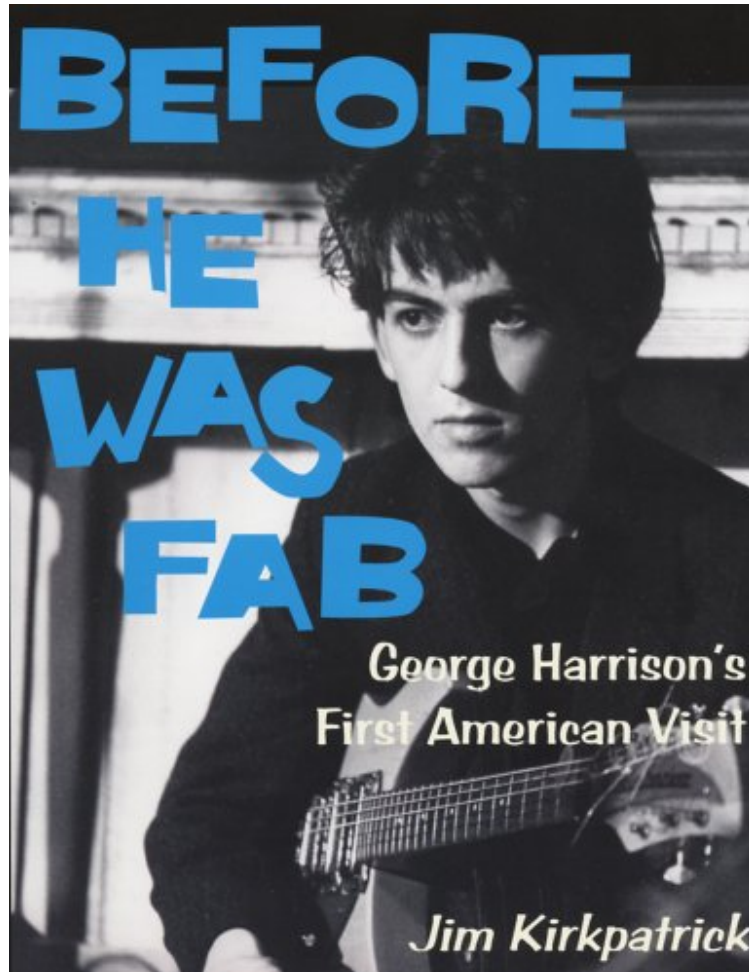

His sister Louise provides a fresh voice, humor and delightful additional input about her famous brother and the people such as herself and their brother Peter who, undoubtedly helped influence George.
