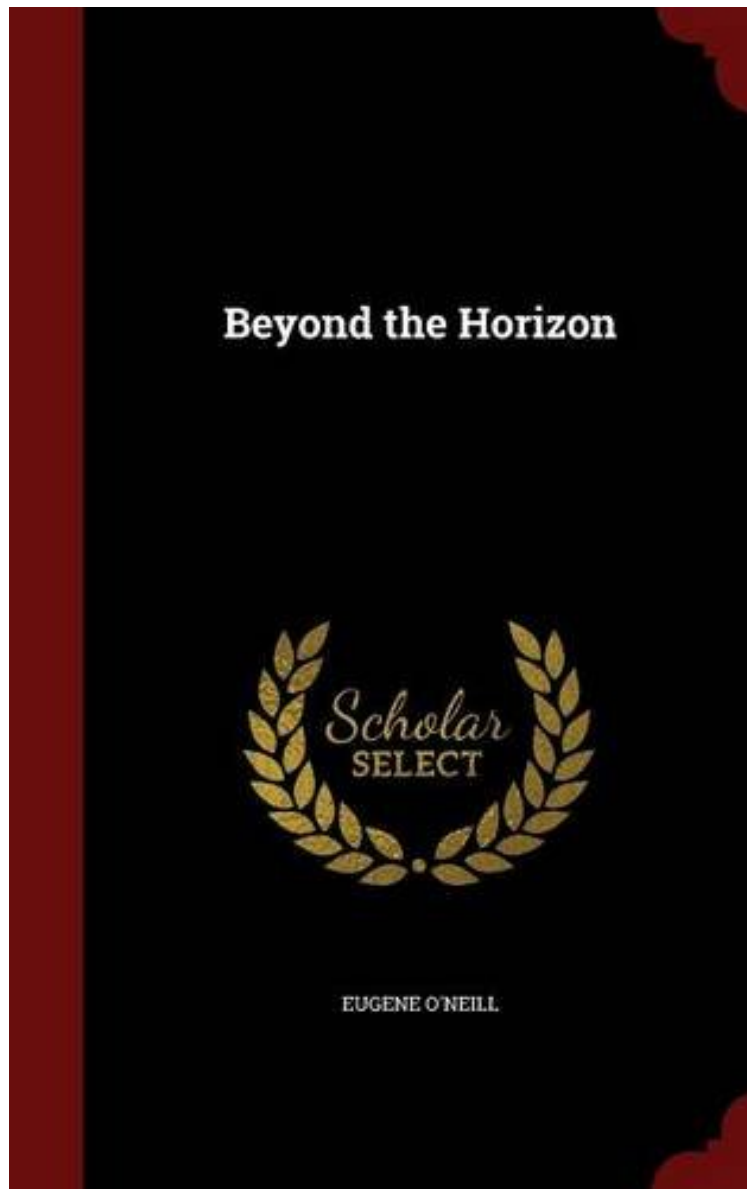

The language controlled, effective, and understandable--the wildest word in the whole play is "slut," for which the speaker apologizes almost immediately. I like to have my students reading plays that deal with issues they can expect to experience themselves. This is one of those, more so than, say, *The Glass Menagerie*. The only problem is that there is no good filmed version of stage or screenplay and not even a readily available soundtrack. Perhaps success in the current production will change that.
