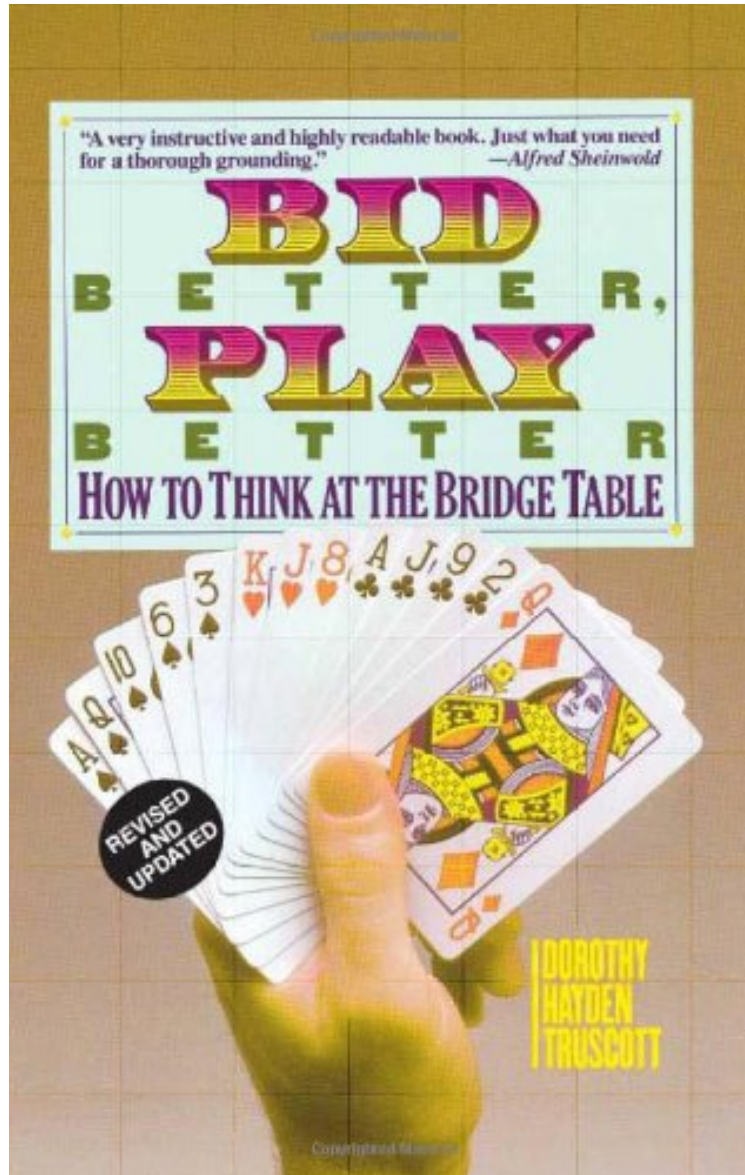

21 of 21 people found the following review helpful. The Kindle edition needs a human editor By Steve The Kindle edition suffers from careless typesetting, almost as though it were computer generated with nobody checking the final

product. Some of the more common errors include mixing up the symbols for suits (e.g., a club instead of a spade), weird spacing ("1 0 876" instead of "10 8 7 6"), and character substitutions (such as "I" or "l" instead of "1"). Having to cope with these frequent errors makes reading the examples and exercises a real chore. As for content and writing style, I agree with the other reviewers that this book is a gem.
