Our 5 year old son is great at the game. It took a few games for the kids to catch on, but now they have their friends come over to play. In the days of hundreds of dollars on video game systems, it is awesome to spend \$14.95 on a game and get so much value. Awesome to replay. There are two ways to play....an easier way where you collect suits of animals or the most animals to get bonus points, avoiding black sheep (Hint: you do need to get one black sheep to get a complete set of animals and six bonus points), or a more advanced system where you get a task card to complete for extra points...in the task card system, if you get the task of collecting all black sheep, you win the game if you "shoot the moon" and collect all the black sheep. The cards are a bit

small (not the size of std. playing cards) and the playing mats are thin, but for the money it is great. The animals are well done and cute. An Entertaining Way to While Away an Hour By Stephen Mann I dunno about you but I still enjoy games intended for a younger market if they have the right amount of adult-kick-back built in and this one does to my mind. The basic premise is that of a bidding game similar to brag or poker involving cards and farm animals, with the prize being various plastic animals that you transfer to your "paddock" - a card that helps you figure out how well you are doing. The goal is to collect as complete a set of animals as you can before the game ends while trying to prevent the others doing the same. You get to decide which animal you are going to try for in a given hand, and there's a bit of strategy and out-think involved (though not enough to scare younger players). I think that both girls and boys would get play value out of this but I no longer have young kids running about the place. I bought this game for an older set of players. Well made and amusing.
