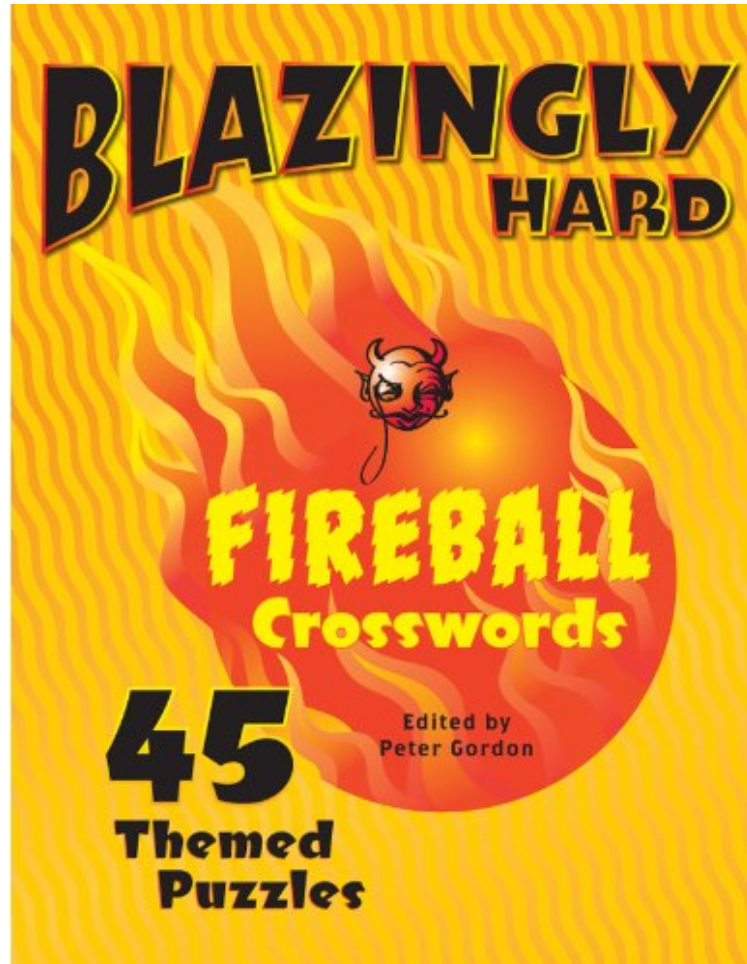

And I LIKE hard puzzles. The inaccuracies were what bothered me. Parts of speech and verb tenses need to be consistent between clue and answer. For example, I cite the clue "vegetable" and the answer "inert." If the clue had been "like a vegetable" or "vegetative," it would have made more sense. Plus the fact that I really hate that "inert" seems to mean "immobile" to many people, and that is not strictly accurate. But perhaps my English teacher is showing. And there were many answers where I thought, who would know that? I don't mind the occasional

reference to sports, but in this book, I got the impression the author didn't know the answers either until they were researched and something, no matter how obscure, was found to fit. That is not challenging. That is lazy craftsmanship, as far as I am concerned. I see that many people liked this book. I did not.
