Save your money and look online for game helpBy Angela Dychel don't know if the other reviewer even opened up the guide.What I got was a "guide" that looked like it was written in Microsoft Word, with images ripped from photo shopped from google (just examine the cover if you don't believe me), and bound at a do-it-yourself book printer.It told all about the story in the game, and I couldn't find much in the way of secrets. I could not find any mention of how to fill in the paint splash locations, where to find the mini paint starts and even how to find the large paint stars was ludicrously difficult! The book has a table of contents, organized by how many chapters there are in the game..and that's it.There is no easy way to find the paint spots, small and large paint stars or Luigi locations listed in the guide, unless it's somehow listed in the "story-telling" parts of the guide. There is no index of items, enemies, bosses or cards. To find help, you have to decipher it in the text yourself. Either

way, it was unhelpful. Also of note: there is no mention of how to build a good deck for combat, help with any of the bosses, help understanding the Thing cards, and nothing mentioned about the "Rock Paper Wizards. You are much better off finding videos on Youtube to get help when you were stuck. (A Prima or BradyGames guide this is not.)*By the way, there is two versions of this "guide": a "color-drained" edition (cute idea, useless in practice since you can't see from the pictures where color needs to be re-added) and this version, which is only slightly better. Best to save your \$25, find game boards and videos online to help you when you get stuck. 0 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
