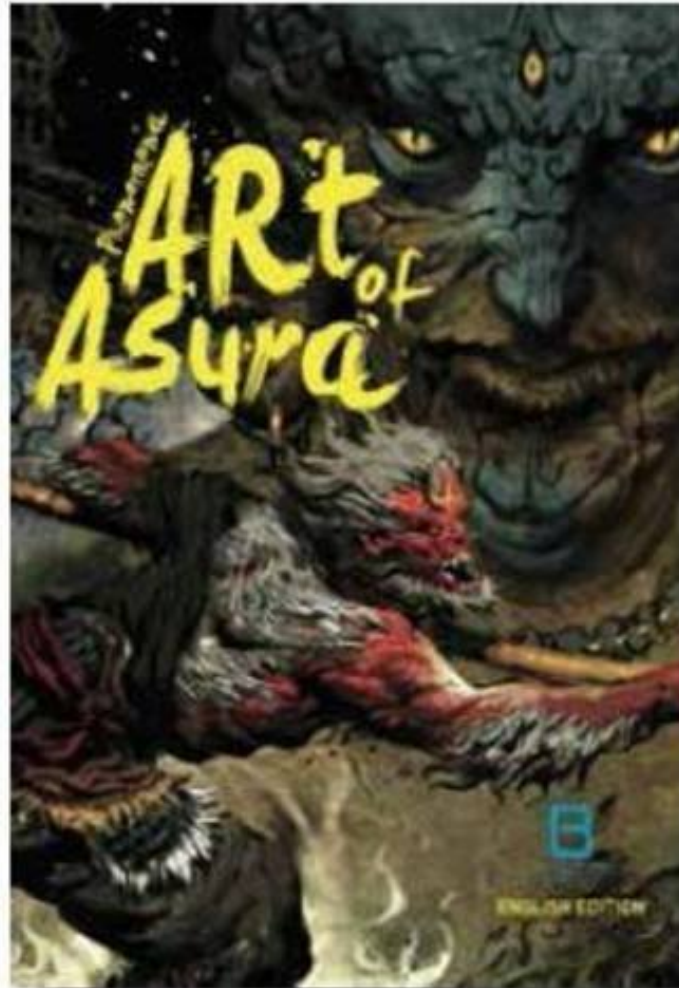

I came to this because Parka Blog, famous reviewer of artbooks, had listed this as his favourite book in 2016 so far, and also because the cinematic trailer for Asura really

impressed me. This is some truly stunning, stunning work, the artwork on environment is excellent but I am especially impressed by the creature/character designs. Those are often the parts that interest me a lot in art of books, and they really excel with that here. There is text as well at the beginning laying out the start of the war. I feel there should be a lot more text in description of the characters though, that is my one nitpick, and certainly not worth detracting a star from. More info would have been great, but you cannot fault the stupendous artwork here. I've honestly not seen so many great fantasy drawings collected in one book. 280 pages by the way, which is a very serious size for this sort of book.
