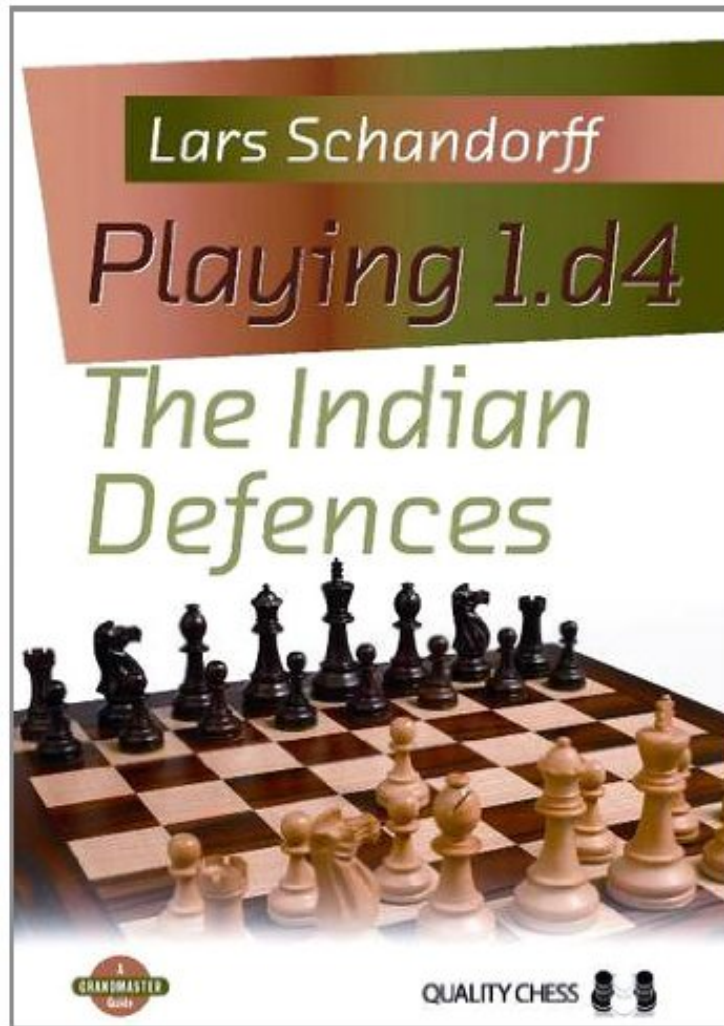

Nice repertoire book for WhiteBy NC Frequent TravelerA companion volume to his other volume on the Queen's Gambit, Lars Schandorff provides a good set of lines for White following 1.d4 against the various Indian Defenses (1...Nf6) for Black. Generally his recommendations are aggressive promising White a good try for advantage at the cost of some risk on his part (for example using the Samisch Variation against the Kings

Indian Defense results in a fighting game with chances for both sides.) I recommend this book for a player of 1.d4 who is looking for fighting chess in essentially main line variations (which are more demanding than the offbeat lines that some authors choose but potentially more rewarding in the long term.)

Chess players are offered an ambitious repertoire for White with 1.d4 in two volumes, with this book covering all lines except 1...d5. The repertoire is based on classical lines and inspired by Botvinnik's approach. Schandorff presents the ideas and information in an accessible and entertaining style. The repertoire is completed by *Playing 1.d4 The Queens Gambit*.
