In many poker books it will seem as if the author somehow magically is getting pocket pairs or A-K on almost every freaking hand! And if they didn't then they bluffed

on the rest. That led me initially to play way way too many hands, making me one of those players who seem to be afraid to fold more than to lose money. I didn't take very long to realize how badly I was playing and quickly adjusted. In this book `Professional Middle Limit Hold'em: Real Play: Hand by Hand' it's good for players to see how many hands in a row you may be folding and why. Perhaps you are dealt rags repeatedly, or you are dealt a weak set and then you are getting raised in front. The author shows how he may play these hands and allow you to learn from his mistakes. This does lead the book to be a bit dry, but my advice is just take your time and only read about one of his sessions at a time so you give yourself time to absorb the information. This also is not a good book for someone who hasn't read at least a few other books and played some hold'em themselves. While he may make mistakes, the way he thinks and analyzes hands is a great example for those of us who don't even know how to approach actual play systematically. Excellent book By Horusfalke Definitely one of the best poker books I have read. 1) I'm playing mostly low limit hold'em (5-10) and had wished for years that someone would come up with a book that shows you on a hand-by-hand basis how hold'em is played by excellent players. The reason the author gives for playing a hand in a certain way is often sophisticated, however, the book is not intended for beginners. There is no doubt in my mind that the author is a very strong player. 2) The book contains a lot of material I have never seen in print before. That holds true for the second part as well where the author discusses miscellaneous topics. 3) The author is very humble. Finally not one who claims to be the best player in the world. He gives a lot of examples of hands he misplayed with detailed analysis.
