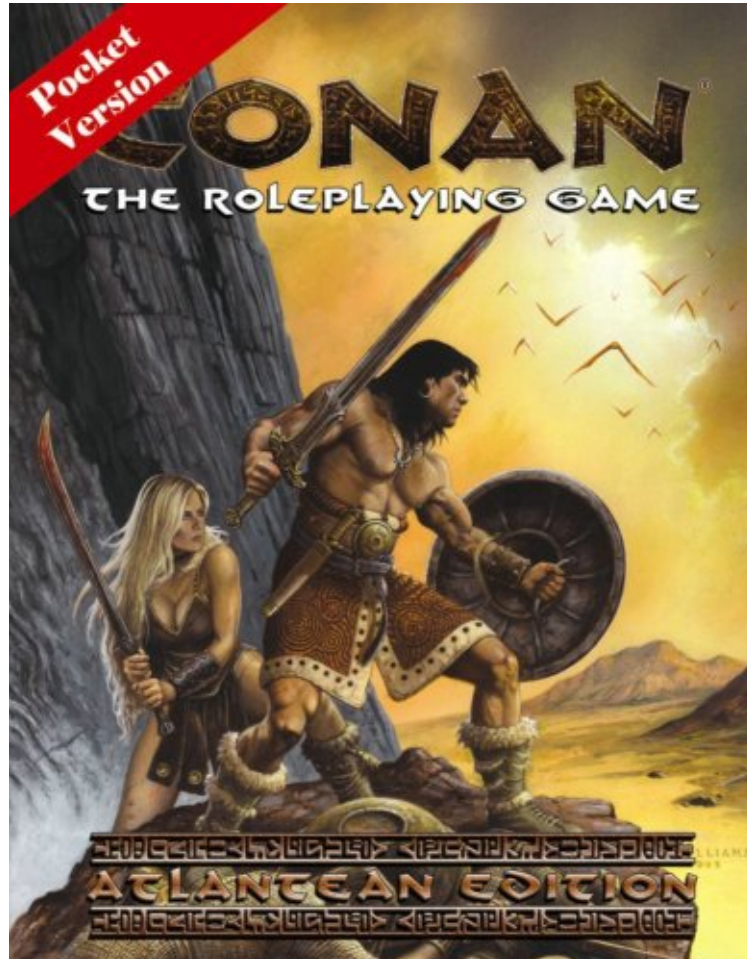

Mongoose Conan RPG are out of print. I love the concept of stripped-down pocket editions. They make much better additions to a game than a player manual, which is what I used mine for, mostly. Easier to lug around than a full sized book too, though you'd need pretty big pockets if you were to take the title at face value. But everyone should be aware that this was printed for the first edition of Conan (as is telegraphed by the cover art executed in primarily yellows and browns rather than 2nd editions blue palette). Much of what is in here will work with second edition, perhaps with a few annotations where there are important changes, but the Temptress class is not represented, some other classes since "retired" are in here and the magic system has been overhauled since this book was printed. So it is really more of a collector's item than a valuable addition to a player's game bag. Physically the book is a perfect bound paperback with black and white printing. The spine is sturdy. The print is clear and sharp. There is little in the way of artwork. In its day it would have been a good buy, with the caveat that many people felt the game system was badly flawed. Today I would think its appeal would be limited. If you are considering getting into this RPG, Conan: The Roleplaying Game, 2nd Edition would be a better use of your dollars (if you can find one in your price range).
