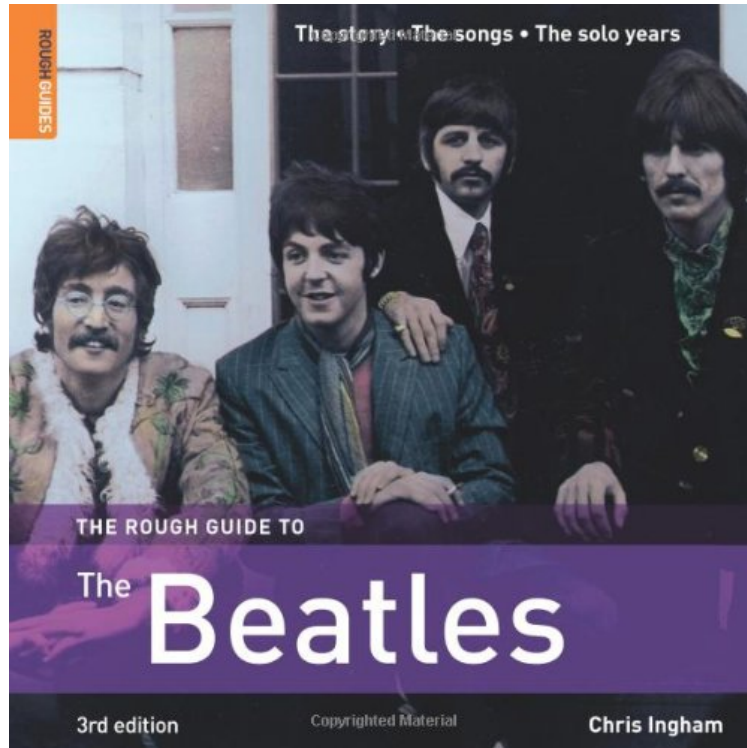

You get the bios of the band-mates, the history, a section on their greatest songs, a discography, and some really interesting sections on things like places mentioned in the songs, candidates for the title of 'The Fifth Beatle', other key players in the Beatles lore, songs that never were, and so forth. This is a fun little book to read and refer to. The particular edition I got was British, so the album tracks were listed as they were released in Britain rather than the States, but there was a shorter American discography with tracks near the back.
