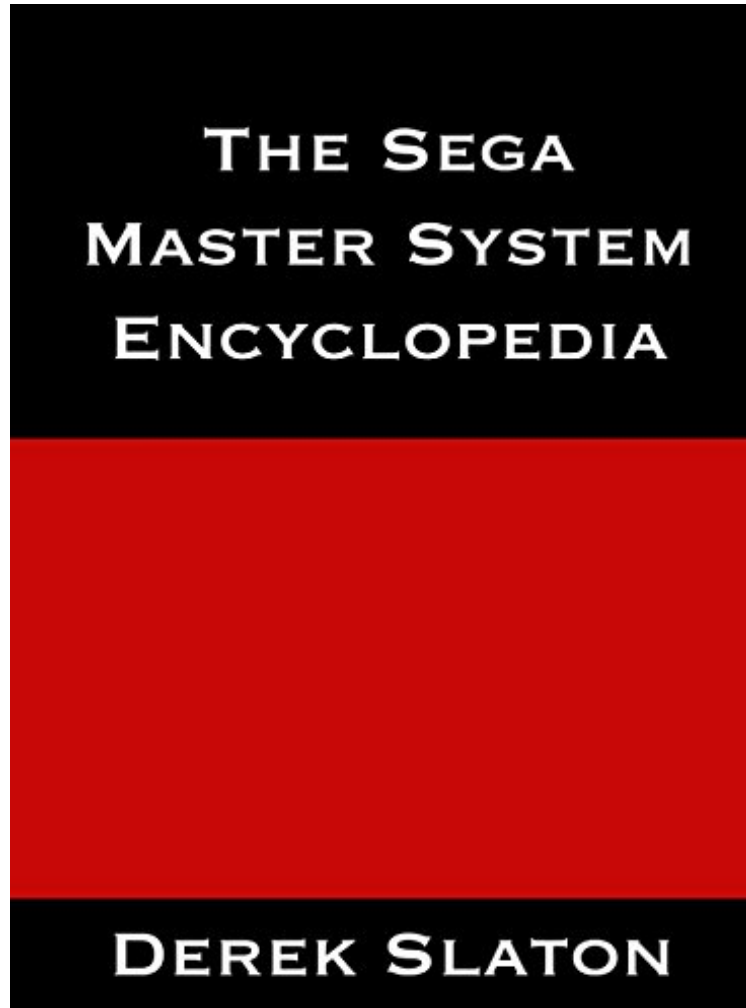

Over the course of 435 pages you'll find that every game has an in depth review, multiple screen shots, and cover scans.
