This deck's artwork is great, though I feel a few cards could have been a bit more dynamic. The card stock is on the thin side but that makes it easier to shuffle. The guidebook is big, which is nice but I was expecting a smaller book and a sturdy box like most oracle decks. I was able to find a good-sized tin book that I lined with cotton for the deck. The cards aren't reversible, which was a bit disappointing because I wanted to have this be my "go-to" deck. But since I'm still new to tarot, it should be good enough for now.
