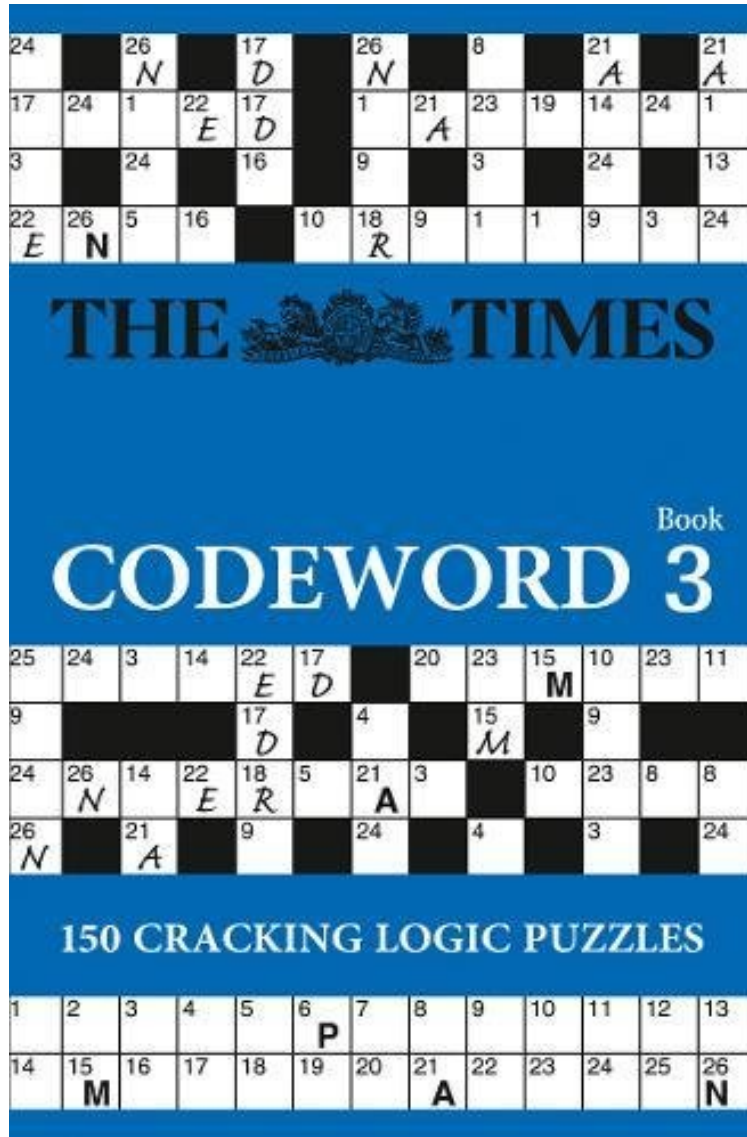

A different, fun to do puzzle!By Careful ConsumerThis book is hard to come by, since it comes from the UK, but the activity of doing a "code word" puzzle is much more fun, to me, than a simple crossword!Each letter of the alphabet is assigned a number, and then the letters are placed correspondingly into the numbered blanks in the puzzle to make words, but you've got to figure out which number belongs to which

letter (or vice-versa!). It's a bit challenging at times, but I've worked so many crossword puzzles that I was ready for a change. The puzzles in this book are challenging, but not too too challenging that they simply can't be worked. I always tear out a couple of pages and staple them together and put them in my purse to work while I'm sitting in the Dr.'s office, etc. (I could put the whole book I guess, but there's just not room enough in my purse...)
