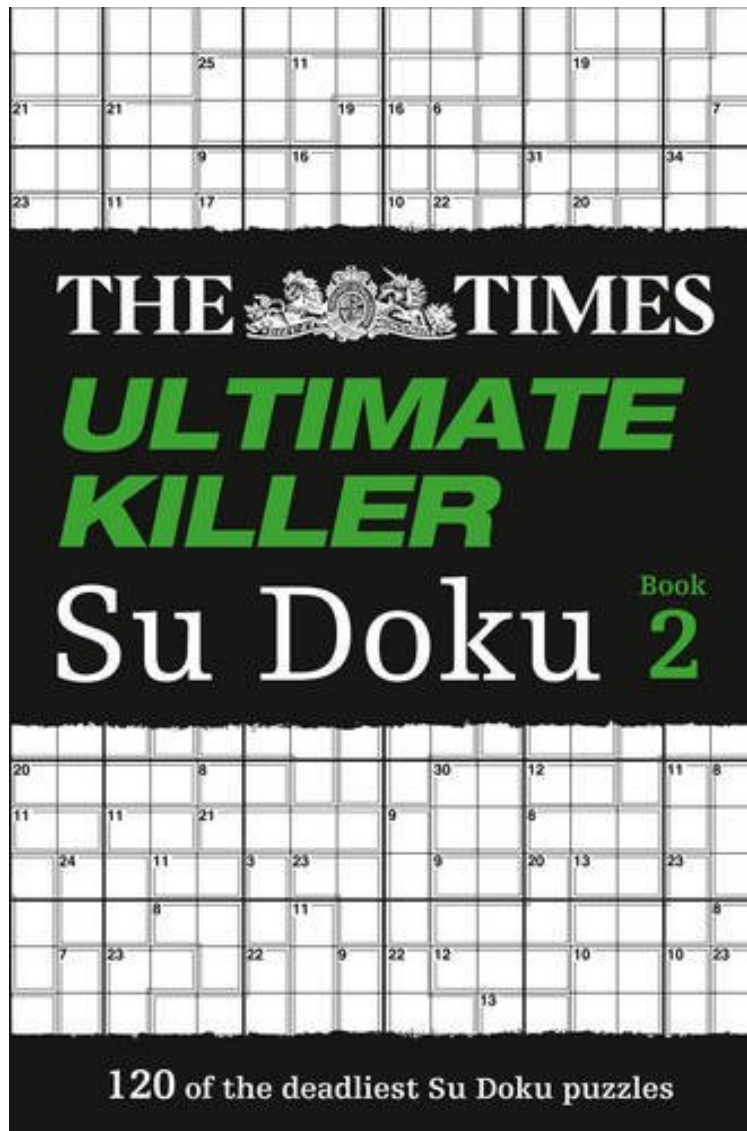

And if you are considering the London Times Ultimate book, you are probably looking for tougher puzzles (just like their crossword!)Normally I print the Friday, Saturday, Sunday and weekly puzzles from killersudokuonline but when I'm travelling I prefer a handy little book. With most Killer Sudoku books you are lucky if there are three or four puzzles that are challenging. With this

book you get up to 20 that will take at least several minutes to solve. If you are familiar with Killer Sudoku on line, I would say the hardest puzzles in this book fall in the category of "Hard" to "Extreme" with final most difficult puzzle maybe reaching the "Outrageous" category (Sorry- no "Mindbending"). I wish puzzle makers would get together and come up with a consistent degree of difficulty formula! Also that someone would come out with a book of only harder puzzles. Powell I've been doing these puzzles from The Times for years now and usually their collections are challenging and fun, however there are too many "gimme" puzzles for my taste which is why I was so looking forward to some ultimate action. Went straight to the "Extreme" section and did two puzzles in twenty minutes that were supposed to take \*four hours\*. C'mon. While I am always quick to point out how smart I am ;-), in this case I think the puzzles might just be dumb. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Just Like The Others in The Series By Diane Algebra I've purchased others in the series but will not buy more. The paper quality is like a coloring book - it does not hold-up to erasing and tears easily. The puzzles can be completed in much less than the suggested times. Too often I've gotten stuck and resorted to cheating. The book will kill time but not enjoyably.

For those who like to live dangerously and push beyond their mental comfort zone, steel yourself for the second book in The Times' toughest Killer series yet.
