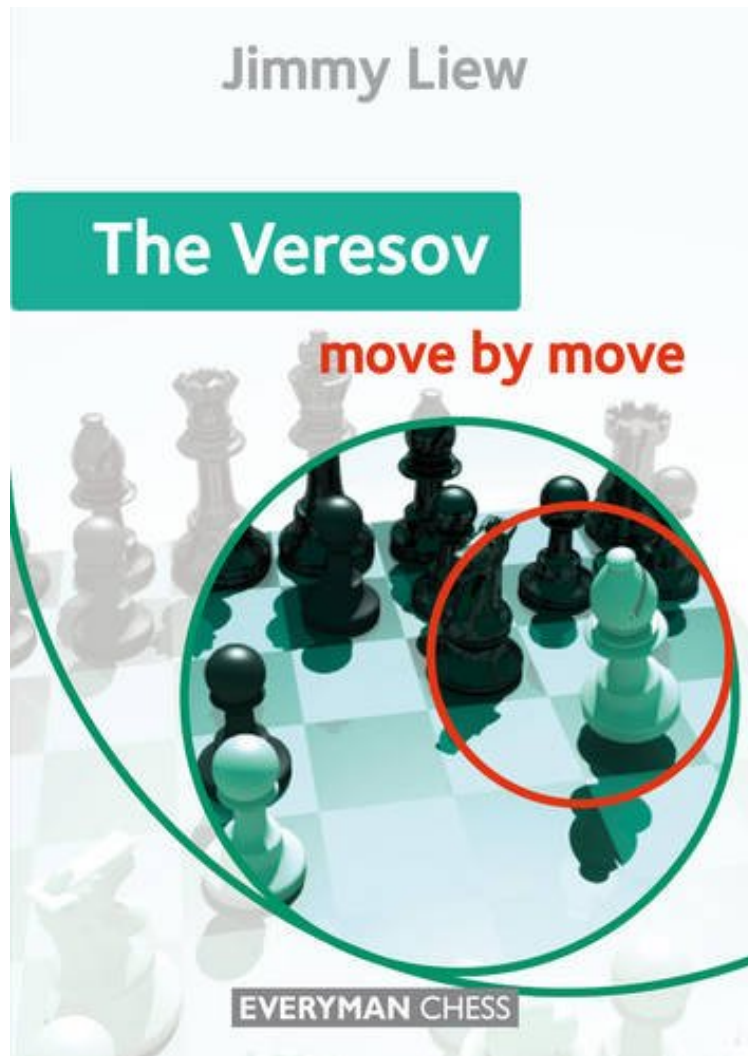

"The Veresov: Move by Move" is no exception. It is primarily aimed at intermediate chess players and slightly lower. My primary use for this book is a supplement to the DVD The Wicked Veresov Attack by Andrew Martin. While some of Andrew Martin's DVDs are very light in content, he always does a professional presentation. And when Martin uses the Chessbase educational model as he does with the aforementioned DVD it is very helpful. In regards to

Jimmy Liew's book, besides the notes in the games, the most useful remarks appear in summaries of Black's replies to 1. d4 2. Nc3. For example, in Chapter Three The Solid 3 ... c6 1. d4 d5 2. Nc3 Nf6 3. Bg5 c6 is a common reply from those black players who are not prepared to meet the Veresov. They do not believe that White will really give up his bishop by capturing on f6. The move is also attractive since it defends the d5-pawn and, more importantly, makes way for the queen to go to b6 or a5 to exploit the move 3 Bg5. Here, again, I recommend to go ahead and take that knight.
