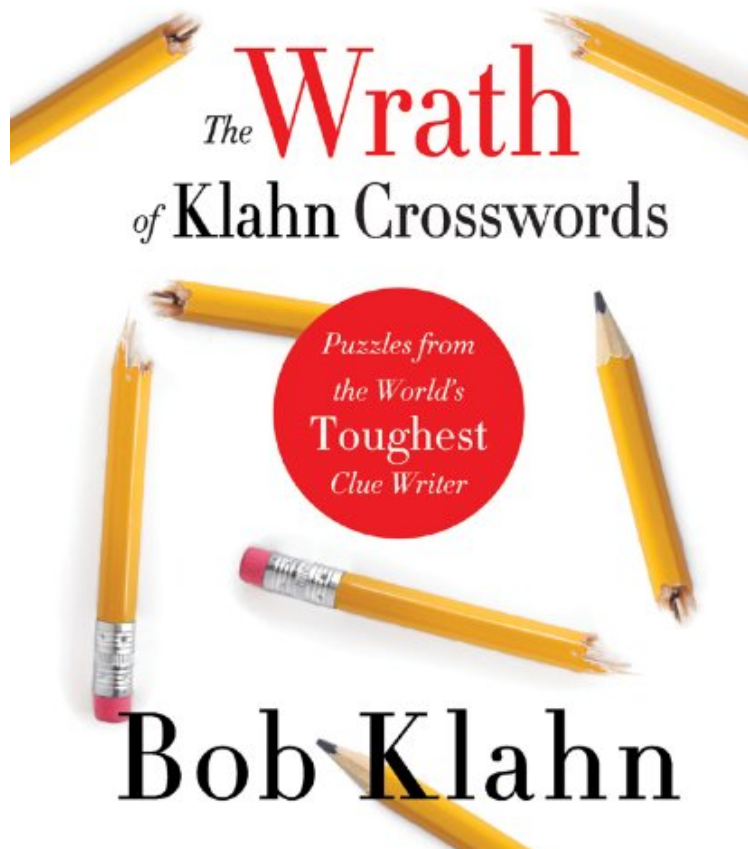

This is a bit overboard for me. First, they are theme-less. Ergo all the major clues/answers are randomly all over the map. And did I mention very tough too? It is easier for him to develop an extremely hard puzzle that doesn't have to follow a theme than to be a bit fairer and lead the solver down a logical trail of answers.BK is the master at odd clues such that when you solve you say ah-ha. (He sells you on that point in his introduction... enjoying those ah-ha moments.) Well this is a collection of them, with some even a bit overboard and almost indefensible as to their validity.
