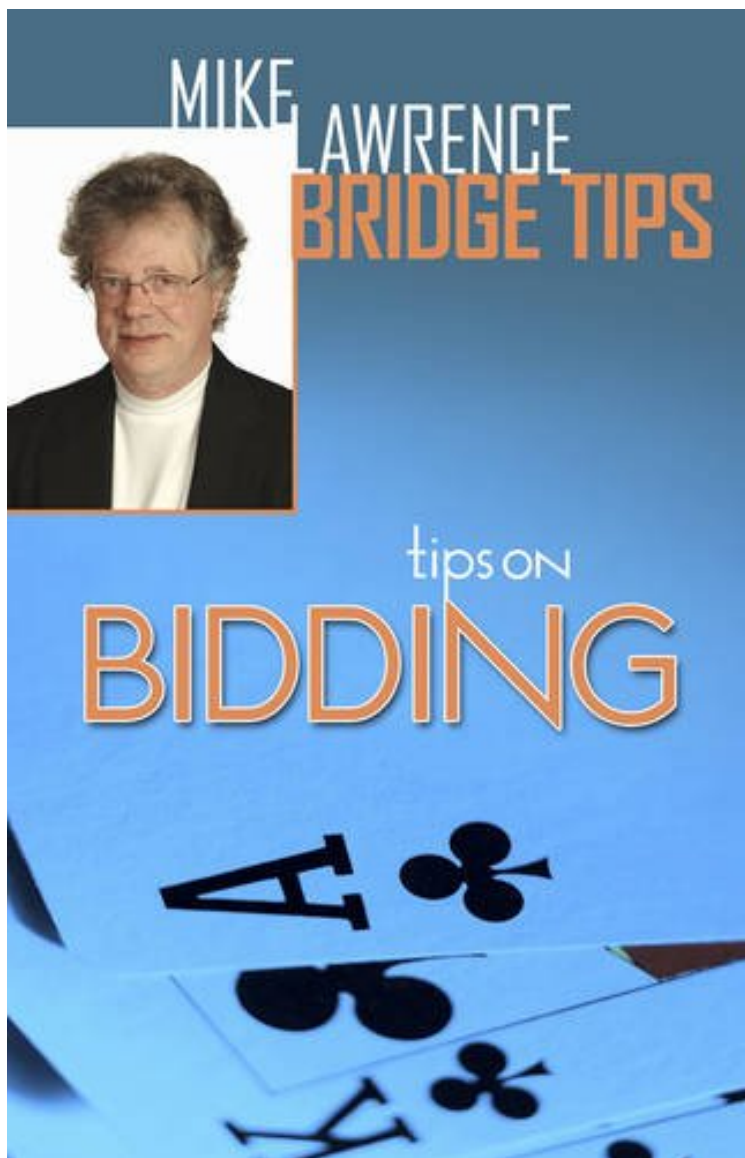

Can be defined in 1-2 sentences and 30 seconds (most people's definition). This book treats the subject in about 40 pages!! Preempts at 3-4 level are also detailed. I'm still reading through. Long unavailable, this material has now been revised, updated, and republished in three anthology volumes, each comprising about 10 of the original booklets. Mike Lawrence is acknowledged as one of the two or three best writers in the world for intermediate players. First volume in a three-volume series based on bridge tips for intermediate players first published twenty years ago. All the material has been completely revised and updated.
