Decent Snapshot But Very Incomplete By Gift Card Recipient It's a decent snapshot - if you're just starting out - it's a decent snapshot of whats out there but they don't know the Disney Cars series all that well. They seem unaware of that the first Desert series is really split into two distinct releases with some "no promos" ones worth much more (for example). None of the rest of the yearly series is very complete either. They don't seem to realize that a bunch of the cars from the World

of Cars series has the NEW snipe. Or for the really rare stuff, they run low res photos since they don't actually have that item. The layout is still very 1960's old school - but that's the Tomart way - nothing is ever same sized. Serious collectors who want the complete photo of every release of should check out the takefiveaday magazines. The ones from the TakeFive series is all high res and complete ... and that's the big thing - whats the point of a guide that is only about 65% complete? Overall, an ok starter one for little kids to look over but for serious collectors of this lineup, pretty inadequate in terms of release info, incomplete photos design that is out of date.

Tomart's CARS collector s price guide is complete with listings up through new 2010 models as releases in the Mattel 2010 Collectors Guide. Included are the original models released on the Radiator Springs Desert, Supercharged, World of Cars, Race-O-Rama, Final Lap, Look - My Eyes Move, and Car Toon card backs. There are over 750 photos shown in full color. Many CARS have also changed names from series to series and not all are die cast. Some or all CARS included in playsets and all Color Changers are plastic. This and other important collector information are found throughout this new volume. Store exclusives singles, series, and gift packs are listed year-by-year along with variations and special promotional items. Value research has been done on several internet auctions and sales sites. Flea markets, car, and toy shows throughout the mid-west have been visited to acquire items shown in this guide and research local selling prices. The result is one of the most comprehensive books on Disney/Pixar CARS published to date. Readers even get a sneak peak of the life-size Radiator Springs currently under construction at the new Cars land at Disney's California Adventure at the Disneyland Resort.
