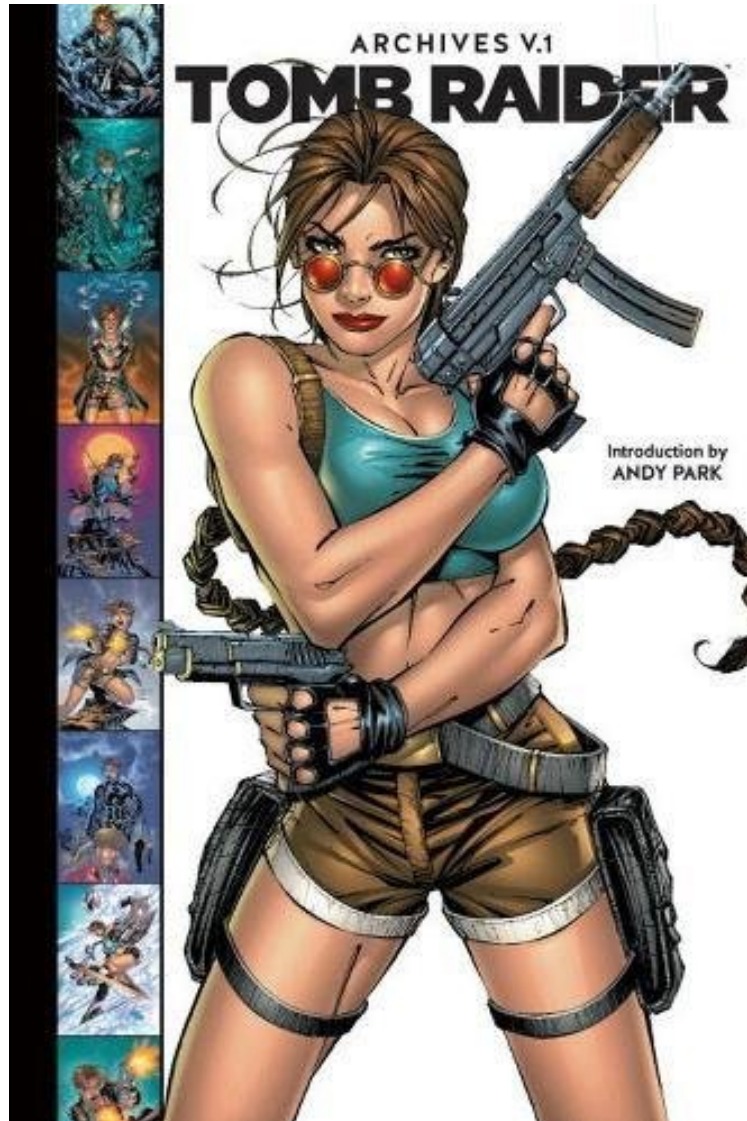

The stories are fantastic and feature Lara Croft in adventures retrieving artifacts from beautiful locales. If you have never read the series before, this version of Lara is more like the character in the older games or Lara Croft and the Guardian of Light than the 2013 reboot of Tomb Raider. Thus, the focus is much more on archaeology and mythology than gritty survival.
