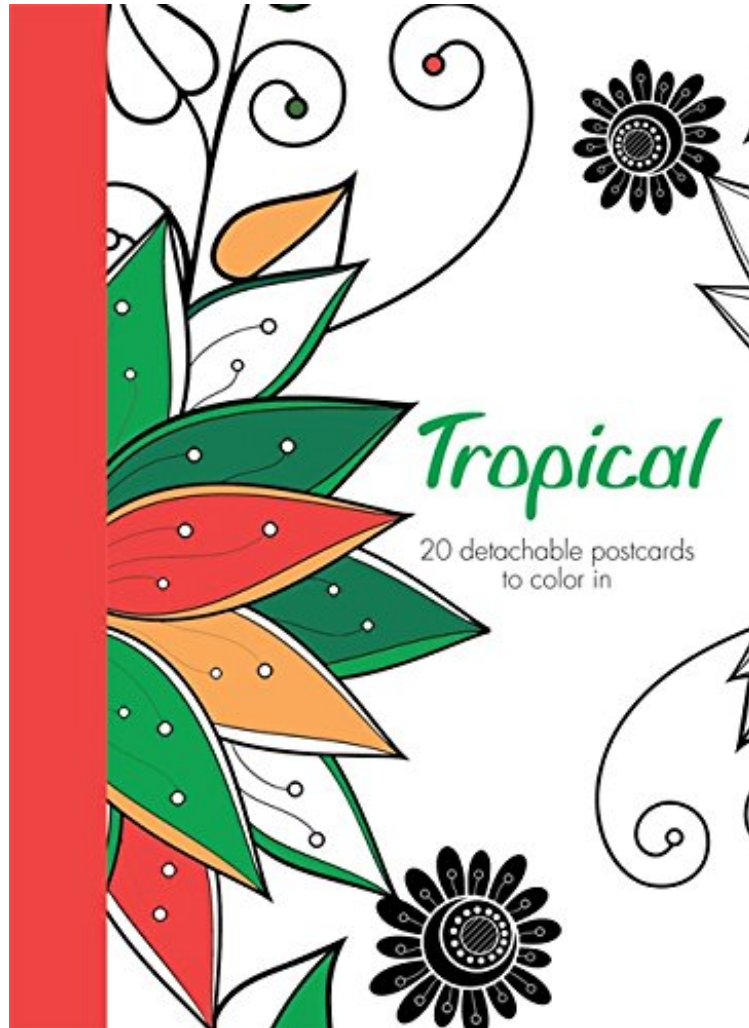

It is even heavier than the 110lb card stock that I use for printing coloring pages. I used gel pens, Pitt markers, Tombow markers, and none of them bled through. I also used watercolor pencils and an aqua brush with very little warping of the paper.The 20 designs have a nice variety in complexity too. Some are very simple, some have tiny detail. Each card measures 4.5x6.5", and has the standard postcard markings on the back. There are quite a few tropical birds, flowers, fish, and abstract designs. The printing and line art is very sharp and good quality.I have really enjoyed coloring these! They make a

nice, quick project you can finish in an evening while watching TV.
